



# **Bike the Douglas State Trail**

**Saturday, August 8, 2015**

**Meet 10:00 AM, Depart 10:30**

**From the Pine Island Trailhead**

The Douglas Trail is a 12.5 mile scenic, well paved, mostly tree-canopied trail between Pine Island and Rochester going through countryside and farmlands near the meandering Zumbro River. A shorter option of 7.5 miles is to start at Douglas. Bring a picnic lunch which we'll enjoy at the Rochester trailhead (picnic tables and restrooms) before returning to Pine Island.

**Helmets required.**

**Directions to Pine Island:** Go south on Hwy 52 and take the second Pine Island exit at Co Rd 11, turn right (west) and go about half a mile to the trailhead in Pine Island City Park on the left. There are restrooms.

**Directions to Douglas:** Go south on Hwy 52 past Pine Island to the Douglas exit on Olmstead Co Rd 14, turn right and go approximately three miles to the railhead. There are restrooms.
