Driving Directions: Take 35W South (toward Lakeville). Exit on County Road 46th Street (East) toward Apple Valley/Rosemount (approximately 9 mi.) Go Past Hwy #3/Robert Street and turn Right onto to Station Trail (across from Dakota Aggregate). Follow this gravel road** past farm fields to stop sign (1.4 mi.). Go straight ahead. Turn right at Whitetail Woods sign and follow road straight ahead to the end (1.4 mi). Parking lot and picnic shelter are on the right. Parking and park entrance are free.
