Directions to DNR Boat Landing from Bloomington: East I-494 toward South St Paul, look for exit 64B (Highway 156/Concord Ave), ramp to stop light, left (north), continue under bridge to first stoplight. Right on Villuame Ave, follow to Hardman. Left on Hardman (north) to Verdosa Ave (watch for brown DNR boat landing sign). Right on Verdosa, cross railroad tracks to parking area. Porta potties available.

There is an all day party at the German America Institute at 301 Summit Ave in St Paul, great German food and beer and wonderful music and entertainment. So, we are going to bike to the festivities.
