MEET AT 9:15; RIDE AT 9:30 (ABOUT 20 MILES)

Come “out east” and see the sights on this end of the world. Meet at the parking lot by Carmine’s Restaurant, 9900 Valley Creek Rd, Woodbury. We’ll ride around some of Woodbury’s lakes (yes, we have a few), then cross Hwy 94 to head over to the Lake Elmo Park Reserve, which is a real gem if you’ve never been there. There are bike paths along the entire route, but we will be contending with several traffic lights by the freeway crossing.

If you have the time and energy after that, there is another Washington County asset you might be interested in that is about a 4 mile drive from Carmine’s.
