

St. Croix River Paddling

11 am Tuesday, July 11, 2017



Our trip begins at Interstate State Park in Taylors Falls, MN. You can choose to canoe (2 persons) or kayak (1 person) for the seven river miles to the take out across the river from Osceola, WI. Experience canoeing or kayaking is advised. This program is open to prospective ULLR members who sign up in advance. Bring a sandwich or a snack and a drink for a stop on one of the many river islands. The length of our trip will be about four to five hours.

We need a minimum of six canoes or kayak rentals. Sign up and payment is due by June 30th, but you may cancel up to July 7th. After that there are no refunds. Rental fee is \$30 per canoe or kayak (one person), and includes personal flotation device, paddles and shuttle bus. We will paddle rain or shine, however, if 48 hours prior to the program the forecast is for severe weather I will reschedule the program for another date. Parking at Interstate State Park is \$5 daily.
