What do you find in a genealogy library? The Library Resource Center (LRC) in the Minnesota Genealogy Center library has over 30,000 books, historical and genealogical periodicals, many microfilms from area Roman Catholic churches, older Minnesota city directories, maps, and other items. The on-line catalog of the LRC collection will help you see if a resource is in the library. The collection, all donated, represents many nationalities and countries. The computers have many helpful links to sites that will help you with your research, including the library edition of Ancestry. The LRC is an affiliate branch for the LDS (Mormon) Library holdings.
