See oak savannah restoration work at Terrace Oaks. The project will restore 26 acres of oak savanna in the northcentral portion of the park. Buckthorn and weedy tree species are being removed, and the area will be seeded with prairie and woodland grasses. The end goal of the restoration effort is more usable and aesthetically pleasing areas for park users and improved habitat for plants and wildlife.

Directions from I-35E

Take Exit 90 and drive north on County Road 11.
The entrance to Terrace Oaks West Park is about .7 miles from Exit 90.

Begin hike at 11:00 a.m. Hike about 4 miles.
Trail has several short but steep hills.
Walking sticks or hiking poles are recommended.
