

Wheelock Parkway/ Gateway Trail Ride

Thursday, July 16, 2020

With the reconstruction of Wheelock Parkway complete you can now link up with many local and regional trails in the northern portion of St. Paul. If you haven't ridden in north St. Paul lately join us at the State Fair Grounds. Enter at the main entrance at Dan Patch and Snelling Avenues. At the first stop sign take a right and park along the street. We meet at 9:15 and ride at 9:45.

From the Fair Grounds we ride to Como Regional Park and then on to Wheelock Parkway and east to the Gateway Trail toward Keller and Phalen Regional Parks and the Bruce Vento Regional Trail. We will ride as a group to the intersection of the Gateway and Bruce Vento Regional Trails, approximately 15 miles round trip. From there you ride independently as far east on the Gateway Trail as you'd like or explore the Keller Regional Park trails. Completing our exploration of bike trails in north St. Paul on Thursday, July 23rd, Nan Fergen will lead us on a ride on the Bruce Vento Regional Trail and through Phalen Regional Park. Look for her flyer on the ULLR web site.

Picnic and conversation after the ride at the Fair Grounds. Bring a chair, food and a beverage.
