ULLR Bike Ride - Thursday, September 24<sup>th</sup>

Meet at Spring Lake Park Reserve - *Schaar's Bluff Trailhead*

8395 127<sup>th</sup> St. E., Hastings



Our apologies... Due to the repaving of the trail in the City of Hastings, our ride will begin at the Spring Lake Park Reserve's *Schaar's Bluff Trailhead* located at 8395 127<sup>th</sup> Street E., Hastings. As a result, our biking plan has been revised, as follows:

**Ride for Everyone (8.4 Miles Roundtrip, Est. 1-hour):** Departs *Schaar's Bluff* westward. We will cruise mostly downhill over two impressive trail bridges featuring early fall views of the Mississippi River to the West Trailhead of Spring Lake Park Reserve. Once refreshed, we will retrace our journey with optional photo-op stops to soften the challenging uphill terrain back to *Schaar's Bluff*. If you have had enough biking for the day, you're encouraged to grab your BYO picnic lunch, chair and join other like-minded friends in enjoying the great views and conversation.

However, if you are looking for another challenge, the following option is designed just for you.

**Optional Add-on Ride: (9 Miles Roundtrip, Est. 45 min.)** Once assembled, we will depart *Schaar's Bluff* eastward. While not nearly as scenic as our initial ride, we will enjoy rolling hills and flat terrain on trails and a connecting city street to a scenic Overlook near the Hastings Lock & Dam. After a brief Photo-op, we will burn even more calories biking back to *Schaar's Bluff*. Finally, we will have an opportunity to join others in picnic lunch conversations.
