Zug Zug is the fictional caveman creation of Minneapolis artist, Zach Schumack. Zach designed the caveman for an advertising event and thought it was a shame to have Zug Zug stored in his garage so he approached the Minneapolis Park Board to see if the statue could be placed in one of the parks for the winter. He felt it was important for people to have something positive to talk about in 2021.

Zug Zug is made of clay and encased in a block of ice made of plexiglass. A mannequin from a Burnsville Mall was used to create the statue.

We will hike approximately 2+ miles past Zug Zug and onto a snowy path up and around the park area.
