Barn Bluff in Red Wing is their most famous landmark. Forming over a half billion years ago with the help of glacial meltwaters. Prehistoric humans lived in the area and even built burial mounds atop the bluff. Sometime around 1815, the Mdewakanton Dakota camped near the base of the bluff and used the top of bluff for a lookout. Barn Bluff is named for its shape.
