

Gateway Trail Ride
Lunch at Neumann's Bar, North St. Paul

LOCATION: North St. Paul, Gateway State Trail
Meet at 9:15, Ride at 9:30

Meet and free-park at the North St. Paul Municipal Parking Lot, corner of 7th Ave East and Margaret Street. We'll proceed along the Gateway Trail to Duluth Junction (Brown's Creek Trail entrance), then back to Neumann's Bar and Grill for a total of 15 miles. We can lengthen the ride if we'd like, going further on the Gateway Trail.

DIRECTIONS: Take Highway 36 East to North St. Paul. Exit right on McKnight Rd, then left on 7th Avenue. Proceed to the Municipal Parking Lot, corner of Margaret Street and 7th Avenue.

BIKE TRAIL:

We'll ride on a totally paved State Trail, through tunnels, over bridges, and experience a variety of scenery. We'll enjoy both urban and country views including North St. Paul's giant snowman, wetlands and farm fields.
