## 2010 ULLR Golf Classic



## Keeping The "Luck" in "Potluck"

Special Notes by Karen Gray, Executive VP

So many of our ULLR events are "food centered", and my concern, as a Home Economist, is always food safety. It's no "picnic" to get food poisoning.

Please observe the following food safety practices:

- Wash hands for 20 seconds with soap and water before touching food. After handling raw meat or petting the dog, wash again.
- Wash fresh produce, even melons, before cutting, and keep them cool.
- Do not reuse meat marinade or the utensils and containers used.
- Coolers should be transported in air conditioned cars, not in hot trunks.
- Foods that spoil become dangerous if they spend more than two hours at 40° F — 140° F., or *one hour or less* at above 90° F. +.
- Avoid cross contamination with raw meats to fruits and vegetables, on cutting boards, colanders and all surfaces.
- Defrost food in the refrigerator, microwave or cold water, not on the kitchen counter. Do *not* refreeze thawed food.
