

They ate lunch outdoors overlooking Lake Winsted. It was a wonderful day.





- Exit Bass Lake Road going west.
- Go two blocks: through stop light at Nathan and one more block to Trenton.
- Turn south/left on Trenton and go two blocks—just past corner of 57th Avenue North and Trenton.

We're in the NE corner of the 4-plex—house and drive face Trenton, yellow fire hydrant at end of drive.
