Wax is used on a ski in an attempt to optimize the thickness of the thin film of water between the ski and the snow. Skiing over snow with too much water will create "wet drag" or suction, while too little water will result in "dry drag" or friction. Your ULLR friends will help you pick the best wax for the day when cross country skiing – that is if any two people can agree. ☺

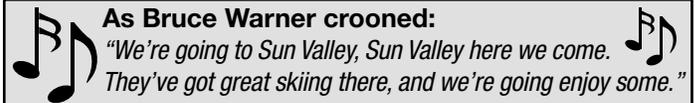
