

SNOWBIRD'S MAGIC CARPET

Conveyor belt rides can be found at several ski areas including Buck Hill. But the Magic Carpet at Snowbird is unique. It is the first of its kind in North America. The 600 foot long tunnel is about 10,500 feet up on the mountainside. It takes skiers from the Peruvian Gulch into Mineral Basin, an intermediate skier's paradise. The 30-inch wide conveyor belt, similar to moving walkways commonly found in airports, takes riders on a relatively flat 4-minute ride. In addition, a \$5.6 million, 8,000-foot-long high-speed quad lift connects riders from the base of the mountain to the passageway. The project's total cost was \$6.5 million.


