THE ULLR RACING TEAMS

For the first time in the history of the race league, all Sunday races were canceled for the first week. It was so cold and windy that both Buck Hill and Wild Mountain were closed. The next seven weeks were not much better. Our teams are a tough bunch, and we made the best of it. It's no fun to be standing at the top of the hill in your GS [Giant Slalom] racing suit waiting your turn when the wind chill is 30 below zero. On top of that, when you're going down the hill at between 30 to 50 miles an hour, you're adding to that wind chill.

New technology has given us better knowledge of how fast we are actually traveling on the hill. Many of us have an app called "Ski Tracks" on our smart phones. I loaned my Ski Tracks to Andrea Bonde. She very demurely tucked it down the front of her GS suit and hopped on the chair lift. At the end of her second run we found she had traveled at 52 miles an hour down the hill. Maybe some of us could bomb the hill at 50 miles an hour but to go around 13 gates at that speed shows the incredible skill that a lot of our team members have. And, it's not just Andrea. Her dad was only a quarter of a second slower, and most of the team was within one or two seconds of that time. That's not a lot of actual difference in speed.

Racing is a wonderful sport to be in. First, there is the personal competition to see if you can be better this week than last. Then, there is a good-natured fellowship among the entire League as we wait to see our team's standing for the day's race.

The Wednesday league at Buck Hill is very competitive.

We didn't win many platinum or gold medals, but we still wound up in the middle of the standings.

2013 STATE BICYCLE MAP

MnDOT published an updated edition of the state's bicycle map, the first since 2001.

Available both in paper and electronic format, the free map provides information on bicycle accommodations across the state, making it easier for cyclists to plan long-distance bicycle trips. Map information includes:

- Roadway details - shoulder width, pavement type and traffic volumes [low or high]
- State and regional trails, including the Mississippi River Trail
- State historic sites, parks, city index and other points of interest
- Safety tips



The electronic version of the map, available at www.mndot.gov/bike/maps.html and compatible with smart phones, features more detailed routes than the paper version, and includes smaller and printable areas of the state. The online version of the map will be updated twice yearly and offers opportunities for public feedback.

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
