"Debuting in 1906 as an extension of the Twin Cities' street-car system, the *Minnehaha* provided fast and reliable transportation for the tourists and residents of Lake Minnetonka for nearly twenty years. Rising popularity in automobiles caused for her scuttling in 1926. ... the *Minnehaha* lay forgotten at the bottom of the Lake." It was raised in 1980. After 16 years of volunteer labor, it was restored and returned to passenger service in 1996. An ULLR, Bruce Warner, was our capable boat captain. He kept us entertained with Lake Minnetonka history. Eight ULLRs later enjoyed eating at Maynard's Restaurant in Excelsior.
