

A Walk down the ULLR Memory Lane as reported in two November NULLRs

1999: Congratulations were given to the ULLR president and secretary— Jerry Swanberg and Jan Pfarr were married!



Their honeymoon was on a big band cruise on the QE2 through the Panama Canal. The treasurer reported there were no Y2K issues for ULLRs. There was \$15,440 in the bank.

2000: This biking mishap was most unusual. **Sally Chevalier** went to Urgent Care because of a bee sting on her tongue. 25 ULLRs sailed in 5 boats on Lake Superior in sun, rain, no wind, strong wind and mini-storm. **Carol Magnuson, Tom Roberts, and Bill Handsaker** were 3 of the 5 boat captains. **Joyce Krake** and **Barb Carpenter** raved about the ULLR 50th Anniversary Bash. The club was started by Otto Hollaus. He sold ski gear at Schuneman's Department Store in St. Paul. In January, 1950, 32 people attended a meeting in the store's basement. At that time only 3 local areas had ski rope tows: Lutsen, Moon Valley,* and Telemark. In the 1960's ULLR men kept track of who they wanted to date after ski season. Paychecks didn't stretch for skiing and dating. In the 70's ULLR was the first American ski club to go to New Zealand. In the 80's there were over 1,400 members. By 2000 the average age of an ULLR had doubled, but volunteers continued to keep the club strong and fun.

*Moon Valley Ski Area was west of the Flying Cloud Airport on the banks of the Minnesota River. A tow rope lift ticket was 50¢ for adults and 25¢ for children.



Tractor and Garden Party By Shelly Larson

They were mostly John Deeres, but also a Ford and an International dating to the 1930s and 1940s.
