2005 ULLR President, **Dave Schave**, wrote how he had lost his love for winters in Minnesota. Winter now just provided a good reason to leave for warmer climates. He also wrote the club's declining membership (312) meant there were fewer volunteer leaders. A committee was formed to define a possible future direction for club activities. [Note: 38 members list a "warmer" address today from our current 238 members.]



Cheryl Ostlund (Rogers) invited ULLR folk to attend the Passion Play at North Heights Lutheran Church. The event featured 400 actors, live animals, and music.

Judith Simon announced a new event, Tuesday Singles Fine Dining at TCO (Twin Cities Originals) independently owned restaurants.

Dick Wilkes' Treasurer nomination resume harkened back to WCCO radio when he promised, "If elected, the club's monies would be perfectly safe, and never invested in anything speculative like pork bellies."

2007 Gary Gray organized a play and backstage tour of "the new and very avant-garde" Guthrie Theatre.

Jerry Schuster reported, "12 Ullrs went by van to ski at Ironwood in Michigan." He also said the bar band got better after the skiers had a few drinks.

Margie Seklund chaired a Singles event, Indoor Miniature Golf, in Eagan. Dinner afterwards was at Casper's in its "non-smoking" dining room.

The Foundation President wrote as opportunities to earn money had lessened, memorial gifts had supplied almost half of the money raised in 2006 for adaptive equipment requests. (The membership was aging!)

Manfred Deutsch (and **Margie**) became the Folding Party Coordinators, taking over from **Gary Gray** and **Margo Dinneen**.

Snow, 10+ inches on Feb. 2, didn't keep hardy bike commuters off the local streets. This was fitting as the 3-day Winter Cycling Congress was meeting at the University of Minnesota. The Congress is trying to help make more cities around the world biker friendly during all seasons. About 350 leaders, with many different areas of interest and expertise, came from across the world for forums where they made and listened to suggestions. A goal is to learn about all the benefits year-round cycling can support in terms of health, wealth, happiness and equality.

NOTICE OF ELECTION


