

**LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT**

Greetings Ullrs!

Thanks to Nancy Sand for hosting the winter planning party. Karen Holmquist and Barb Kolbe worked out a schedule for the winter months. You will find it on the web site and in the NULLR. We have some new sites for hikes, and snowshoeing, and still some old, favorites sites. The schedule starts out great but the events start to get light for January, February, and March. It would be nice to see some Ullrs come forward with some events for those months. Volunteer!

We have had five of the What's Cookin' picnics. Ullrs seem to be coming earlier to socialize, and to beat the heavy traffic and road construction. The July 20<sup>th</sup> picnic had a turnout of 77 Ullrs. This was good because the temperature was in the 90's, and the humidity was really high. But we had a good wind which helped to make it feel better. I know some of the biking events have been canceled because of the heat. Also, no one showed up for golf before the July 20th picnic.

The Board is still looking at some job descriptions and procedures, etc. So far, we haven't found a lot that really have to be changed or rewritten.

The Club got some good news for the ski trip to Park City. Southwest Airlines came in with their rates. They were over \$100.00 less expensive than Delta and offer free checked bags, so we canceled our Delta reservation. The price is now \$978. Now is the time to sign up. We will be opening the trip to the MSC in August.

**Treasurer's Report**

I looked back to the year 2013/2014 and the cost for printing, mailing and folding parties was \$6,221. This past year the cost was \$225. What a great savings! With that savings, the Board approved subsidizing part of the Spring Banquet. Your dues for the next year are only \$20. Also, we are waving the administration fees on all events in the current year. Your Board will continue to see what we can do to give back to the Club.

**Food Safety!** On these hot summer days, don't invite Salmonella or Lysteria to your picnic. Use these common sense rules. Prepare foods with clean hands on clean areas. Do not thaw frozen items at room temperature. Marinate food in the refrigerator. Keep cold foods cold and hot foods hot. Cook your meat at the picnic site. Use a meat thermometer. Internal temperature for beef, pork-145°, ground meat-160°, chicken-165°. In hot weather, food should not sit out for more than an hour. Serve in small bowls, keep the remainder in the ice chest. **Be safe, not sorry!**
