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
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LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Are health issues keeping you from riding a bike? Try an E-bike.

In Germany in 2014, Manfred and I rode his cousins' electric bikes. You still have to pedal to make the bike go, you are still getting exercise, but you will go faster and further with a lot more ease. And climbing a hill can be fun! Bikes are powered by a quiet electric motor (maximum of 750 watts) at speeds up to 20 mph. Both limits are all that is allowed in the U.S.A. One rider said he felt as though he was "being coaxed forward by an invisible force." If the motor is built into the frame, the motor drives the rear wheel. There are also conversion kits which replace a wheel and have the motor sitting on a rear rack. Rides can be about 50-55 miles before the motor needs recharging. These bikes are expensive— but most current riders wish they had gotten them sooner. *Margie Deutsch*

Bill joined ULLR in the 1950's. He enjoyed both down hill and cross country skiing and led trips for both. He was a sailor and led many sailing trips to the Apostle Islands. He traveled far and wide and entertained the club with his stunning travel photos. Bill served on several ULLR Boards and was a Vice President. In 2002, he was named ULLR of the Year. The celebration of life for Bill Handsaker will take place Tuesday, Nov. 1, at 11:00 AM at

the Ramada Plaza Hotel, 1330 Industrial Blvd, Minneapolis.

The Club offers condolences to his family and friends.

In 2015, Bill donated "decades worth of photo albums created by his father, Willard Nelson Handsaker, to the Minnesota Historical Society. Willard Nelson Handsaker was a railroad engineer, a dedicated father of three and an obsessive photographer. From 1932 to 1973, he captured his every month in pictures, from his home life in St. Paul's Macalester-Groveland neighborhood to company retirements, track accidents and the giant ice palaces of the St. Paul Winter Carnival."
