## And so it began in 1950

Downtown St. Paul was the place to shop with its nine department stores. Otto Hollaus worked in the outdoor activities area selling ski gear at Schunemans. He had an idea and got permission to use an area in the basement for a meeting. 32 young adults met and the ULLR Ski Club was begun. Later meetings were held in the St. Paul YMCA. At that time there were only three local ski areas that had tow ropes- Lutsen (ski hill opened in 1948), Moon Valley (across the river from Shakopee on Highway 169) and Telmark (by Cable, Wisconsin, opened in 1947.) The skiers would bring duct tape to repair the holes in their mittens.

### Who was Otto Hollaus? By Margie Deutsch

His Declaration of Intention said that Otto Robert Hollaus arrived to New York on the ship Queen Mary on May 8, 1939. He was born in 1906 in Berlin, Germany but had moved to Vienna and become a citizen

of Austria. He was a professor of Physical Culture who spoke English. He fit the Aryan ideal of a German at 5'11", 150 lbs. and having fair complexion, blue eyes and blonde hair. He served in the U.S. Army from 1943-45. He moved to St. Paul after the war. He died in St. Paul on Sep. 30, 1989. Otto was a skier!!

Awards with interesting names were presented: Bear Tracks, Equipment Wrecker, Loose Pole, Navigation, Stray Chair and Anti Snow-boarder. (When a snow boarder ran across the tails of Dave's skis, Dave was told he should watch where he was going as he was on the boarder's blind side. Oh my!)

**Linda Heintz** led skiers and showshoers to a new destination, Wausau, Wisconsin. At Rib Mountain State Park the snowshoers were happy to see that some trails had already been used, helping them to figure out where to go. "Although, as Larry Miller and Alan Moore were with them, they didn't worry too much about little things like trails."

## NOTICE OF ELECTION

**Election of officers for the ULLR Ski, Bike and Social Club will take place during the Annual Meeting which will be held Thursday, April 23, 2020**, at the Bloomington Event

Center (KC Hall.) Officers to be elected are President, Executive Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Winter Programs Vice President, Summer Programs Vice President, and Membership Vice President. (The current President automatically assumes the position of Past President and becomes a Lifetime Honorary Member of the Club.)

**Candidates for offices will be presented by the Nominating Committee at the ULLR General Meeting on March 12, 2020.** At that time, any additional nominations must be made from the floor.
