Getting ready to Ride—Margie Deutsch

All winter, your bike has sat, neglected and lonely, in a darkened garage. But spring is in the air, and before that first ride you need to give your trusty steed some love.

There are many places on the web that will tell you how to give your bike a good tune-up, such as at <https://gearjunkie.com/biking>

I read several lists long enough to know that I have no idea how to do any of it. If that's true for you, find someone or some shop that will do this needed spring maintenance. But I could do these:

Check that frame pump or CO2 inflator/cartridges are in working order.

Check the saddle bag for tools. Is the condition of the spare tube OK? Do you have your repair kit?

Is your lock and chain there? Do you remember the combination?

Did you replace that cheap rain poncho after you used it last year?

Are your chap stick, sunscreen and comb there? (Helmet hair is always so lovely.)

Check the seat—no, not the bike seat—your seat. You haven't sat on that little bike seat for a long ride all winter. Go a few short rides to remind yourself.

Mississippi River Rafting Monday, June 27, 2022

Raft down the Mississippi River while learning about the trappers, lumberjacks, and river dogs that are part of Minnesota's history. Discover what life was like living and working on the Mississippi. Search for water fowl, ospreys, bald eagles and other river inhabitants. You will be paddling while guided by experienced naturalists from Three Rivers Parks.

We meet at 9:15am at River Park, 253 83rd Avenue North, Brooklyn Park.

At 9:30am we car pool 3.5 miles to Mississippi Gateway Regional Park where we'll launch our rafts into the Mississippi River. Includes all equipment. *No experience is necessary.* This program takes place rain or shine. Cancellation will be decided by the naturalist for safety considerations. If cancelled the program will be rescheduled or your payment refunded. We'll take out at River Park and assist our boat captain in packing up the raft for its trip home. Please bring a chair, food and beverage for a picnic and socializing at River Park after rafting.
