

Elections, then, were competitive events. I ran for treasurer and lost. Membership was 1200+ versus our approximately 150 today. There were two western ski trips each year and frequently an additional trip to Europe for downhill skiing. Many of the 70+ ski hills I skied on, in three countries, no longer exist.

Lift tickets were \$10-15 depending on where you were. The ski area in UP Michigan opened in about 1960 and I used to rent a bunk at a vacant farm house for \$2 a night. Six of us would share a car for a weekend trip starting Friday night. It was understood that you were single.

I rejoined about 20 years ago. Our club is dramatically different today. Is our club still relevant? I've been asked why did I volunteer again? I already volunteer at four other places. My answer is too long for here, so I hope you will ask me in person.

There are many events coming in the next three months. I hope you will participate. They are all on our web site administered by Wayne Jastremski, a volunteer. *[They are also in the Nullr.]* Please contact me or any officer with your thoughts about our events or our club's future. I look forward to a dialogue with you.

wonderful - after the long cold and snowy
winter. The bull frogs were chirping, the gulls
were screeching, geese pairing up, and we spot-
ted a pileated woodpecker. Another hiker spotted
a single loon on the lake, but too far out to confirm.

Much of the hike was on trails in the wooded
sections where we had some hills and rougher
terrain than the paved pathways. Following the
hike seven of us had lunch at Steele & Hops, a
local hot spot - opting for inside eating versus the
outdoor patio.
