LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT Nancy Navis



An Honorary Membership

I have been told that at one time, there were 1,000 members in the ULLR club. But that was one year. How many had left the club before that year, and how many have additionally joined since then in the club's 74-year history? Probably over 1400 fun-loving people have been ULLR members.

Dolly Eastman just told me about a category I was not aware of, Honorary Members. She came across a picture among her Big Sky pictures and it reminded her that Chet was an Honorary Member of the ULLR Ski Club. Dolly wrote, "The first year it [Big Sky] was open I was there skiing with the ULLR Ski Club and the second time our club ran a trip there, I was there. If I could still ski, I would have been there this last time also! I really liked that place. The Honorary list used to be published in the membership roster, but I don't know why it was stopped."

Some of us are old enough to remember Chet Huntley. Here is a bit about him from Wikipedia.

Chester Robert "Chet" Huntley (Dec. 10, 1911 in Cardwell, Montana - Mar. 20, 1974 in Big Sky, Montana) was an American television newscaster. He was best known for co-anchoring NBC's evening news program, *The Huntley-Brinkley Report*, for 14 years beginning in 1956.

Huntley's last NBC News broadcast was aired on July 31, 1970. He returned to Montana, where he conceived and built Big Sky, a ski resort south of Bozeman, which opened in December 1973.

Huntley died of lung cancer on March 20, 1974, at his home in Big Sky at the age of 62, three days before the opening ceremonies for Big Sky.
